The conference is open to contributions related to **economics, sociology, political science, demography, spatial economics and statistics on pensions and ageing**, covering the following themes:

- economic and demographic cycles, public transfers and private transfers linked to the ageing of the population,
- demographic aspects of retirement (life expectancy, differential mortality, conjugal behavior...),
- labour market, end-of-career and retirement (career paths, ageing workforce, health at work, arduous jobs, employment of older workers, working in retirement, employer behavior and early retirements...),
- retirement behavior,
- specificities according to professional status (employees, civil servants, self-employed workers...),
- macroeconomic modelling and financing of retirement systems,
- microsimulation modelling of pensions and ageing,
- reform evaluations,
- savings behavior, wealth accumulation and preferences,
- financial management of pension schemes (funded schemes, reserves),
- inequalities in retirement and ageing (inter and intra-generational inequalities, gender issues...),
- living conditions of retirees, residential mobility, housing conditions, ageing and health, entry into nursing homes, isolation, ageing and territories,
- social participation, sharing of domestic work within households,
- financing and provision of long-term care.

The journals "Revue de l'OFCE" and "Revue d'économie politique" may publish, in two special issues, some contributions presented at the Workshop on Retirement and Aging, after a refereeing process organized by each journal.

**Contributions will be selected by submitting a complete paper.**
